 - a. Will have Justin send sign-up genius link to Jr. Redwings parents to get more volunteers. Football games make our program around \$400.
 - ii. 3-point-A-Thon (first Friday practice, Nov. 11)
 1. Garrett to develop more, fundraiser for part of night, Red-White scrimmage to follow (parents invited), then parent social at location TBD after?
 - iii. Simulator Golf Outing (March at T&C?)
 1. Will look into further in future
 - iv. Other ideas?
 1. Talk about selling items (but almost all clubs are doing a sale, cautious as to not oversaturate), Packer game concessions (long days/lots of work). Plan to look at 3-point-A-Thon and Simulator Golf Outing paired with Jr. Redwings host dates. If that is sufficient fundraising, can keep it at that to not burn out parents/volunteers.

 - i. Past two years have gone with QR code on admissions table that links to website
 1. Everyone was good with continuing this path. Will look to Chris Horen to possibly create program graphic for website.
 - c. Senior posters
 - i. Volleyball one for every senior and hangs them up during matches
 1. Will talk with Abby Sigler on how they handle getting these made
 - ii. Would like to get something made for seniors for basketball (6-7 this year)

- iii. Chris Horen has helped created posters for Senior Night in years past
 - d. Game Nights
 - i. Friday, Feb. 3 – Jr Redwings Night (vs Ashwaubenon)
 - 1. Kevin Herber point person
 - ii. Thursday, Feb. 16 – Senior Night (vs Bay Port)
 - 1. Could use senior parents to organize and lead
 - iii. Others?
 - 1. Plan to keep nights at those above for now
- 4. Jr Redwings, Justin Bingham
 - a. Clinics begin next week (Oct. 11/13), practices begin following week (Oct. 18)
 - b. Host dates – Nov. 5 and Jan. 21 (tentative)
 - i. Confirmed with Booster Club tonight they will make sure concession stand is stocked (Nov. 5 is typically down time between Fall/Winter seasons). All we will need is to supply workers.
 - c. Volunteers needed for concessions/admissions
 - i. Will push to have HS families help to allow Jr Redwing parents to watch kids play
 - ii. HS players to work scorer's table/admissions/concessions
 - iii. Sign-up genius will be sent out soon
 - 1. Suggestion to schedule 1-hour shifts (this is how boys handle their host dates). If Jr Redwing parents are needed, would allow them to watch daughter play, jump into stand for hour off, then go back and watch play again.
 - d. Uniforms for future seasons (23-24 and beyond)
 - i. Look at setting up online ordering of jerseys. Families responsible for ordering and then can keep/use for as long as it fits or is needed. Eliminates hassle of trying to collect jerseys, figuring out when to hand them out, when to get them ordered. For first year, could look at only requiring purchase of jersey top with optional shorts (to help keep costs down).
 - ii. Shooting shirts for all youth players. Could have names on back. Look into placing an order next week or week after once we know final count of Jr Redwings players and try and get for this season.
